Prior to lodging an application for accreditation for an Interstate Certification Assurance (ICA) arrangement for the above procedure, applicants should be able to successfully complete the following checklist -

	Do you hold a current copy of the Operational Procedure Cold Treatment (ICA-07)?. Have you retained a copy of the Business's current Application for an ICA Arrangement.? Do you understand the restrictions of accreditation under Parts A & B? Have you implemented a system of identifying treatment lots before loading into the coolroom (A)? Have you prepared records for;: Calibration of sensors and recorders (A); Coldroom loading and treatment (A); Cold treatment declarations (A – non packers); Cold treatment packing (B); Cold treatment (if no objective recording equipment - A)?	
Equ	Have you requested a book of Plant Health Assurance Certificates (B)? Do you have a detailed facility plan with numbers and sizes of treatment rooms (A)? Do you have suitable locks and signs on the treatment coldrooms (A)? Have you verified that accuracy and resolution of sensing and recording equipment is adequate for this procedure (A)? Do you have the facility for downloading and printing data from data loggers (A)?
